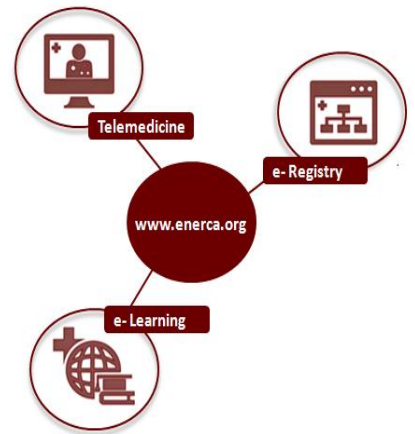

ERN in Rare haematological diseases...

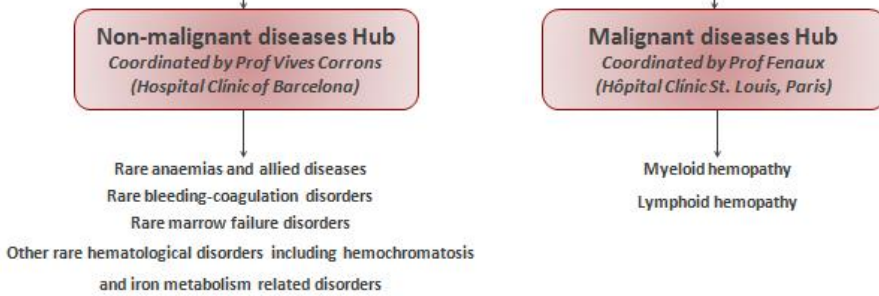
Endorsed by the European Hematology Association (EHA) a unique proposal for Rare Hematological diseases will be presented encompassing both non-malignant and malignant hematology - EuroBloodNet.

Global coordination will equally rotate among the two coordinators hubs. Prof. Vives Corrns will be the coordinator of the proposal and for the first period of the network.

IT Tools

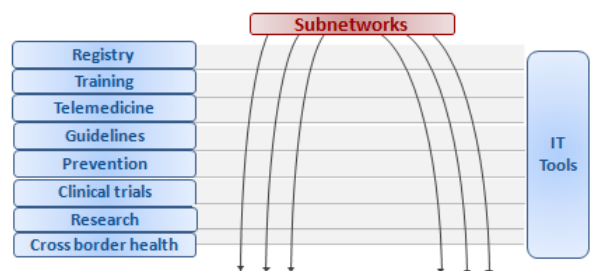
IT tools will have an essential transversal role within the network supporting key fields of action.

The three e-health platforms developed by ENERCA project in the field of rare anaemias will undoubtedly serve as first stones for their expansion and coverage to all RHD.

Key objectives

- 1) Enhance the equality in the care delivery for RHD across Europe by the establishment of **European inventory of experts, centres, facilities available** and distribution of patients
- 2) To facilitate the **harmonization** of the haematology and paediatric (haematology) specialities curricula throughout the EU
- 3) Provide **interprofessional consultation** and sharing of knowledge through the exchange of clinical information for the improvement of patient care
- 4) Promote the **best practices** in prevention, diagnosis and clinical care across Europe
- 5) **Foster European cooperation** in highly specialized diagnosis, health care and research

Transversal fields



What have we done so far?

The scope of the ERN has been established by the coverage definition under the umbrella of EuroBloodNet into different **subnetworks** and the identification of **key fields of action** for transversal lines of work. Moreover we are currently providing **support for health care providers** interested in becoming part of the ERN to approach their local or national authorities.
